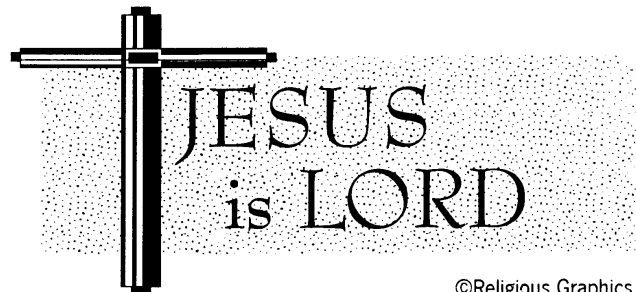

**125 Years....125 Stories**

*As part of our year-long anniversary celebration, in each bulletin there will be some facts and historical curiosities about our parish and the people who have shaped our heritage for the past 125 years. If you have any stories or remembrances, please contact Jean in the parish office or Fr. Justin. So let's count down to number 1!*

**#84:** During the 1920's through the 1940's it was the custom at the school that all desks were bolted to the floor. For much of this time the maintenance and "bolting of the desks" was handled by Carmen Pape.

**#83:** Beneath the sandstone façade of our present church is a layer of red brick. These are the original bricks from the first church, demolished in 1941. Fr. Turner had the school children clean the bricks as insulation for the new building.

**#82:** Many former students in our school remember that Msgr. Joseph Wehrle would hold classes in the rectory. Classrooms were set up in the basement and office areas and Monsignor himself taught Latin in the living room. He even had chalkboards installed on the living room walls!

To purchase a calendar, just stop in the school or rectory office or contact any school parent. Calendars are also available in the gathering space following the weekend Masses.

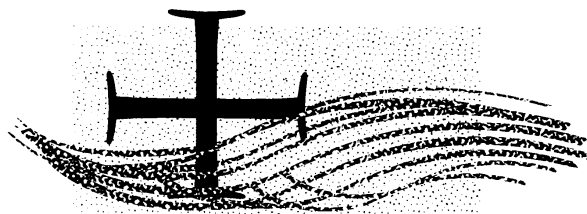
