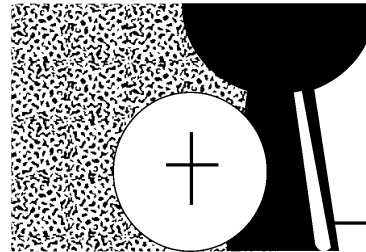

125 Years....125 Stories

As part of our year-long anniversary celebration, in each bulletin there will be some facts and historical curiosities about our parish and the people who have shaped our heritage for the past 125 years. If you have any stories or remembrances, please contact Jean in the parish office or Fr. Justin. So let's count down to number 1!

75 Of the many priestly vocations from our parish, the first young man to answer the Lord's call was Leo Bennis of the same family whose home is now part of the Historical Society - The Bennis House. Sadly, Leo never saw his ordination day. He died as a novice for the Society of Jesus, or Jesuits, in New York City.

#74 It was very unusual in the 19th Century for priests to return to a previous assignment; ever rarer was that these anomalies occur in the 20th Century. In our portion of the Diocese it has happened more than once. Fr. Michael O'Sullivan returned as the pastor of St. Basil's in Coalport in 1896; Father Joseph Reschini returned to Walston as pastor in 1922; and our pastor, Msgr. Riccardo, returned here in 2006.

#73 Perhaps you have asked yourself why we chose the color scheme and art motifs for our renovations. Well, just look to our stained glass windows. There we see the blue and gold color scheme and the dogwood flower, vine and fleur de lis designs. These same designs are found in the interior of the rectory. Msgr. Turner's vision to have such beautiful symmetry for our parish has been renewed for the next 125 years.
