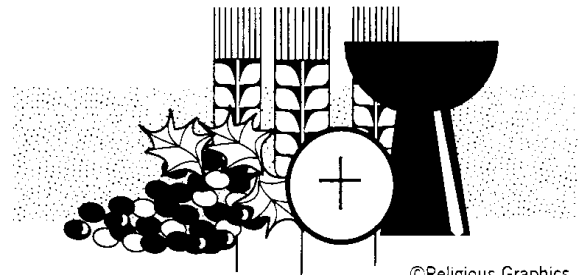

**From The
Desk of Msgr. Riccardo**

Dear Parishioners,

I have had “several associates” throughout my years as a pastor, beginning with Fr. Greg Kirsch, here at SSCD. I always considered them co-workers in the vineyard of the kingdom. Each had their own personality and talents that complimented my own and brought great joy to the parish and to the relationship that I had with each of them.

Moving on is part of our ministry, especially when priests are younger. The structure and needs of the Diocese moves many younger priests in and out of parishes before they really get time to put down roots; a necessity now-a-days and a part of their training to become pastors at such an early age.

As I get older and less mobile, I can only admire these men for their fortitude and willingness to move from one place to another without hesitation. Even though they quietly win over the hearts of so many in the parish, especially the youth, they are asked to give that all up and answer the need of the larger church – which they do without pause.

Fr. Justin was assigned here three years ago with a caveat; it would only be a three-year assignment to help at SSCD and with the parishes of St. Adrian, St. Anthony and St. Joseph. At the end of that assignment an evaluation of the needs of the Diocese and the vitality of these three parishes would be taken. In that three years he would watch and learn to become the pastor he has been appointed to be.

It has been my pleasure to serve with Fr. Justin. As those of you who are parents well know, a young person in the house changes your whole life. His particular talents came just at the right time for SSCD and the surrounding parishes. His invaluable help with the preparations for SSCD’s 125th Anniversary, his untiring work with the children in the School, his ability to put things in order, and scheduling events has allowed both of us to be present to the parishioners of our four parishes. His devotion to priesthood and priestly duties, and all of the above (and more), have made him yet another “person of distinction” in the history of our churches.

I found this little quote which seemed so appropriate for me and for the parishes...especially when we are turning over a new chapter in our own experience of parish life:

“It’s not only children who grow. Parents do too. As much as we watch to see what our children do with their lives, they are watching us to see what we do with ours. I can’t tell my children to reach for the sun. All I can do is reach for it, myself.” ~Joyce Maynard

We wish Fr. Justin the best in his new assignment and express our gratefulness for all that he has done for SSCD, St. Adrian, St. Anthony and St. Joseph. His final weekend with us will be June 12/13; his assignment begins at St. Joseph’s in Oil City on June 19th. We are planning a farewell reception after Mass on June the 12th. Join Fr. Justin for Mass on Saturday evening followed by the reception.

The future will change for us here at SSCD and the Missions of St. Adrian, St. Anthony and St. Joseph. We will need to work together to address the different ministries left by the void. In the next few weeks, I will begin to develop programs that will cover such things as “hospital and home visitations,” “an assimilation of existing ministers into SSCD ministry schedule,” “continuing maintenance programs for the surrounding church buildings,” “installation of security systems in each of three church buildings.” These and 100 other little things will be addressed in the weeks ahead. I will need your help, therefore, I will call on some of you to take responsibility for some of these programs. Please consider helping where you can.

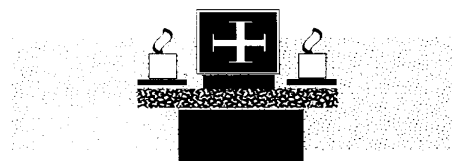
