**25 Years....125 Stories** By: Father Pino

We now turn to a 15-part series on the men who have been ordained to the priesthood, whose seeds of their vocation were planted and their faith nurtured and enlivened here at SS. Cosmas & Damian by the priests they saw and the people with whom they worshipped.

**#37** Of the many assignments held by Fr. James Fleckenstein (1910-1971) he served for many years as the pastor of St. John's Church in Tidioute from 1960-1971. He was ordained a deacon at St. Francis Seminary in Loretto in 1936 by the Most Reverend Richard Thomas Guilfoyle, then the newly installed Bishop of Altoona (1936-1957), who was a native of DeLancey and baptized at SSCD. In fact young James Fleckenstein was Bishop Guilfoyle's first ordination as a Bishop.

**#36** Father Francis Tushim (1917-1992) spent the early years of his priesthood as a teacher at Erie's Cathedral Prep High school from 1943-1958. During that time most young priests taught in the classroom before they were sent to a parish as an assistant, which typically was a long period of time because of the significant number of clergy. Father Tushim spent his later years before retirement as the beloved pastor of Immaculate Heart of Mary Church in Mercer from 1972-1988.

**#35** Father James McCullough (1928-2000) had only ONE assignment in his entire priesthood. He taught mathematics at Gannon University. History has already recorded him as an exemplary teacher and a holy priest. Many of his former students would recall he demanded only the best from them and that is what they got in return from Fr. Jim. His time outside the classroom for many years was spent at Blessed Sacrament Church in Erie where he was a weekend assistant.

**#34** Richard L. Gigliotti (b. 1943) was ordained in 1969. His first assignment was at Our Lady Queen of the Americas in Conneaut Lake and then to St. George Church in Erie as an assistant from 1969-1972.

**#33** Msgr. Charles A. Kaza (b. 1946) has served since 1994 as the Episcopal Vicar of the West, succeeding another Punxsutawney familiar face - Msgr. Joe Book. Another Punxsy connection with Msgr. Kaza is that his first assignment was from 1972-1978 with Msgr. James Daily, a former SSCD assistant. Since 2001 he has been the pastor of St. Tobias Church in Brockway, succeeding the late legend of our diocese, Msgr. Louis J. Heberlein.
